Program description

The chapel program encourages all students to explore what it means to be a disciple of Jesus Christ. We do this by providing a weekly space for students to worship and discover more about God. Although Chapel is explicitly Christian, we strive to make it inviting and welcoming for students of all faith backgrounds. We seek to incorporate a variety of practices in chapel that reflect the diverse denominational backgrounds of our students. These practices include: musical worship, teaching by LCC staff and faculty, the sharing of faith stories, prayer, quiet reflection, corporate readings, visual art, etc.

Student Leader job summary

The Chapel Worship Leaders work closely with the chaplain in developing and implementing weekly chapel services. The primary roles of the student leaders will focus on the musical elements of worship and the discipleship of chapel band members. The student leaders will recruit, train, and lead teams of musicians and sound technicians, and strive to help them grow in Christian faith while fostering positive community. The Chapel Worship Leaders will have the opportunity to grow in their faith by participating in Christian fellowship, spiritual formation activities and a mentoring relationship. The student leader will also grow professionally through continuing education and professional development opportunities.

Areas of responsibility

- recruit, train and coordinate chapel worship teams with support from the chaplain
- encourage Christian faith development among the chapel band members through ongoing discipleship
- plan musical worship for chapel that connects with the chapel theme and/or speaker topic
- develop a repertoire of music that reflects a variety of traditions and worship styles
- lead or facilitate weekly worship team practices

Job standards / Requirements

Experience:

- previous student leader experience is beneficial, but not necessary
- experience leading worship teams and planning musical worship events

Skills:

- ability to articulate a faith in Jesus Christ and how that influences lifestyle
- ability to lead others and work well in a team
- self-starter, demonstrates initiative
- effective communicator

Attributes:

- believes that it is important to share Jesus Christ through actions and words
- desire to grow in personal faith in Jesus Christ
- possesses a commitment to learning more about Jesus Christ through various avenues and spiritual disciplines and to learning more about the Christian traditions represented in the student body
