



Additional regulations and rules for Residence Halls due to quarantine in the Republic of Lithuania

- In common spaces, you are required to wear a mask and to keep at least 2 meters distance between other persons or groups of persons
- If you are a family or belong to a single household, you will have to provide documents, proving the relationship. Otherwise, you will be housed in separate rooms. Exception is made to guests who have been vaccinated (provide a document of proof) or has an antibody test not older than 180 days, proving that the person has recovered from COVID-19.

General rules for protective face masks

Masks are not required to be worn outside when there is no other person in 2 meters radius, except for family members. Masks are also not required to be worn while working out; while in high-mastery sports exercise; while receiving a service that cannot be done with the mask on; for people who have a disability, and due to that disability, they cannot wear a mask or by wearing a mask, it would worsen their health. People who have a disability, therefore, are recommended to wear a face shield; for children who not older than 6-years-old.
