


Housing applications for Academic Year 2021-2022 are now open! If you would like to live on campus for Fall 2021 click <https://lcc.erezlife.com/>. Log in with your LCC username and password. Then, click "apply for housing" to fill out a housing application.



**Dates to know:**

- **Friday, March 5: Housing applications for returning students are due.** *(Late applications will be put on a housing waitlist.)*
- **Wednesday, March 24: Non-refundable 60 EUR housing deposit is due.** *(If you do not pay this deposit by this date, your housing application will be incomplete and will be moved to the waitlist.)*
- **Sunday, March 28 23:59:** Finalize your roommate group by this date so that room-selection priority can be given.
- **March 31-April 2:** Room selection. Select rooms based on points awarded to your roommate group.

We expect to be at capacity in the residence halls next academic year, so it is important to complete your application and pay your housing deposit on time.

**Eligibility**

Returning students who will be able to apply for housing have to meet the following criteria:

- Be enrolled full-time (24 and more credits)
- Enter university in 2018 or later (entering 4th year)
- Be from an area outside of Klaipeda city
- Not be an Erasmus student in Fall

Priority for the spaces will be based on points and their current status:

<i>Points</i>	<i>Criteria</i>
4	Students classified as a freshman
3	Students classified as a sophomore

2	Students classified as a junior
1	Students classified as a senior
3	Students selected for the Leadership Development Program 2021-2022
1	Given to each country represented in the room

## The Residence Halls


Most of Neumann will be reserved for first-year students. Thus, the number of Neumann rooms reserved for returning students will be limited. As additional rooms in Neumann become available, we will try to accommodate building preferences and assign individuals or roommate groups to the open spaces before the start of the fall semester.

## Roommate Groups – Due Sunday, March 28 23:59

**After** you complete your housing application, you can **create roommate groups** or search for roommates from people who have already completed their application.

If you already know who you would like to live with, you can create a roommate group. **To create a roommate group:**

1. Select "Roommate groups" on the left side of the housing system homepage.



2. Select "Create roommate groups."


### Things to keep in mind when forming a group:

- The maximum roommate group size is 4 people.
- Almost every room has a spot reserved for an Erasmus or International exchange student.
- Points for room selection are awarded as stated in the table above.
- It is recommended to try to fill your roommate group, but not required.
- We will do our best to keep a roommate group together, but if there are not enough spaces, you may have to split up. We will try to notify you about this ahead of time.

### **Finding a roommate**

Don't know who you want to live with yet? That's okay too!

To be found on the roommate search, you must first set up your roommate profile by clicking "my roommate profile" on the left-hand side.



First, press the checkbox to enable your roommate profile, this makes your profile visible to others, and allows you to see other profiles.  Turn on my profile

You will be asked to provide a little bit of information about yourself, add a picture if you want, and select which parts of your application answers you would like searchable to others (if any).


