

Four-Year International Business Administration Degree Plan

Important notes on course sequencing (especially for students beginning in Spring term):

ACC 209-210 and ECO 203-204 are only offered in Fall-Spring sequence, and they are prerequisites for later required courses. BUS 209 is offered only in Spring. It may be a prerequisite for elective courses in data analysis.

The Accounting courses are a prerequisite for Business Finance, Business Finance is a prerequisite for Entrepreneurship, and Entrepreneurship is a prerequisite for Final Project Business Plan (and is recommended to take before Final Project Thesis).

Students beginning in Spring semester should take ACC 209 immediately the following Fall, or they will be a semester behind in their course sequence.

Important note for students considering study abroad:

Study abroad is not recommended during sophomore year, unless students are able to take both accounting and economic courses at their host institutions (as well as management information systems, in Spring semester).

If students study abroad during junior year, they might consider taking Business Finance at LCC during the previous May term (unless they can take it at their host institution) and then Entrepreneurship during their semester at LCC.

Business practicum is available every term including summer.

*Freshmen Core Courses:

- ART 100 Arts and Culture
- NAS 100 Introduction to Natural Sciences (or NAS 200 Planetary Health: Environment and Human Health if science exam is passed)
- PSY/COM 121 Interpersonal Communication
- HIS 123 History of World Civilization or ENG 131 Introduction to Literature. If the student chooses not to take HIS 123, then history learning outcomes must be met by taking an approved history course (either in the major or as general elective)
