
A Christian liberal arts university, established in 1991 by a joint venture of Lithuanian, Canadian and American foundations.

of student transformation. We emphasize eight learning outcomes:



An integral part of LCC's uniqueness is providing a North American style education in the region of Eastern Europe.




**Truly International**
