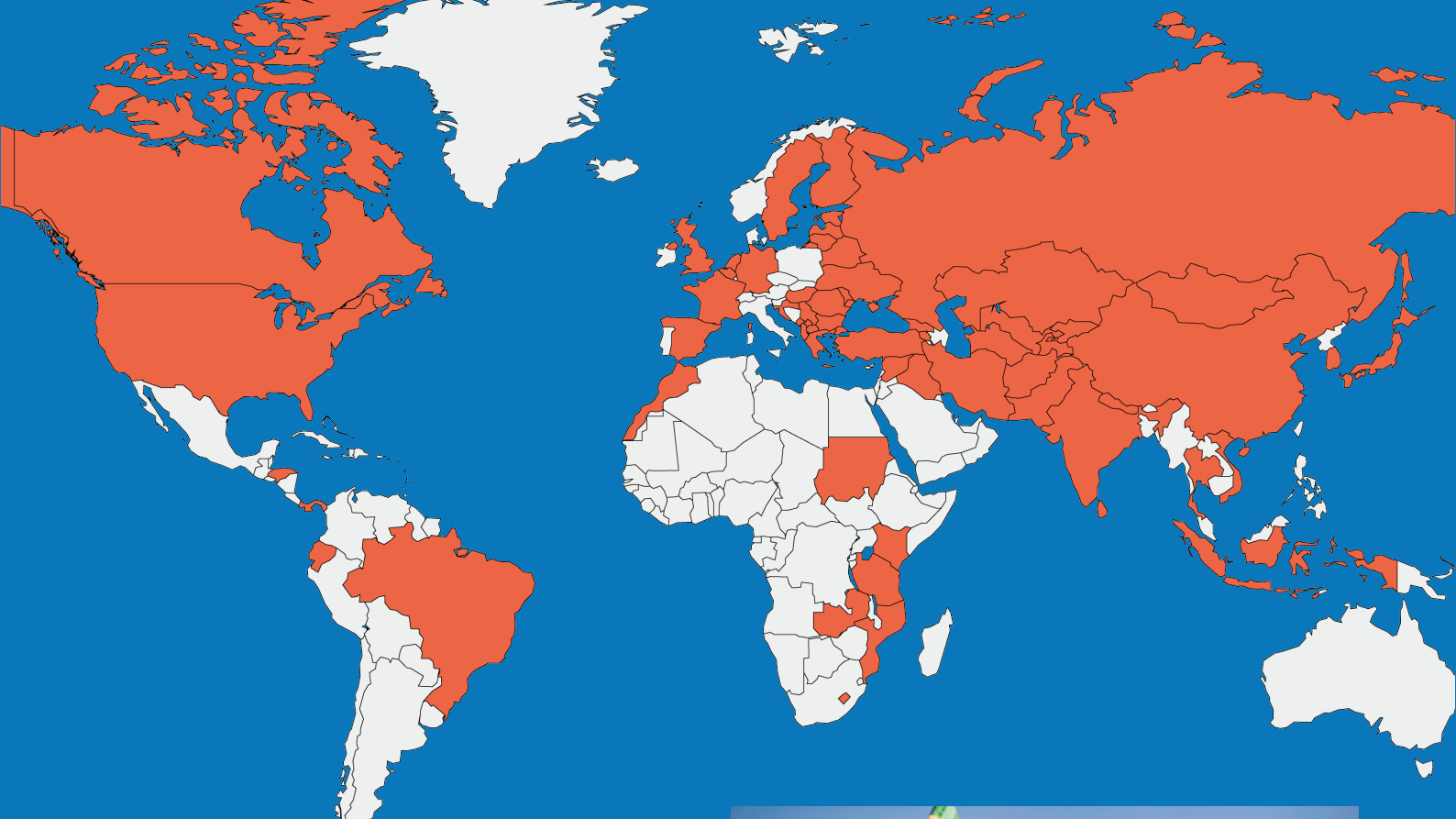
A Christian liberal arts university, established in 1991 by a joint venture of Lithuanian, Canadian and American foundations.
