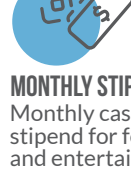
THE UNIVERSITY AND PROGRAM BENEFITS

Students who participate in our programs forge lifelong friendships and enrich their worldview with invaluable cultural and social experiences while discovering Europe.



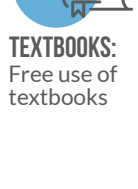

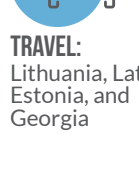
